
## BACKUP AND RESTORE MODULES

All ONLY modules have a non-volatile memory divided into two parts .:

,	Working	memory
	Security	memory

The working memory is the one where the current settings are saved. The security memory is the one where known configuration is copied and kept unchanged.

## **Backup Procedure**



On the front of the D-FDRV module there are keys with names from A to E.

To perform a Backup, press in sequence B A C B A C.

The current configuration in the working memory is copied to the backup memory.

The module indicates that the command was correctly sent to the BUS by turning the 2 fornt LEDs off and on 2 times in a row.

## Restore procedure

To perform a *Restore*, press in sequence C A B C A B. The backup memory configuration is copied to the working memory. The module indicates that the command was correctly sent to the BUS in the same way as described previously.
